History

We will be studying the Ancient Egyptians, looking at the amazing pyramids created by this ancient civilization and learning about their daily lives, rituals and beliefs.

We will using laptops and the iPads for research into our science and topic work.


We will focus on using the internet safely.

Maths

There will be a big focus on mental maths skills and strategies this year. We will mainly be focusing on number in our first term. We will be making sure the children have a range of methods available to solve addition, subtraction, multiplication and division questions.
