



### **Gonerby Hill Foot Friends of the School Association (FSA) fundraising**

As this school year ends, I wanted to send a quick message and ask for some help if you are able.

Luckily, we had enough funds in the bank to follow through on our commitments that we had promised to school this year. There are the annual commitments (which include the wonderful Christmas Tree that the children love to decorate, prizes and games for Christmas parties, a selection box for each child and the year 6 Goodbye DVDs) as well as providing money to help school with their requests throughout this year (£2000 on new books, £2000 for new PE equipment, £2000 towards a shed to replace an old one which stores PE equipment and £700 for new sports kit for the children to wear when representing the school).

We are very pleased we were able to follow through on these commitments but due to not being able to hold any fundraising events the bank account has not been replenished. We very much want to be able to offer all the children next year all the things we have been able to provide in past years and it would be a bonus if there was money to help school with any additional funds if needed.

While we can't hold fund raising events I am asking for those families, in a position to help, to buy lottery tickets from Lottery SK. For each £1 raffle ticket you buy, school get 50p and local charities get 10p. You can win up to £25000 and some of our parents have won £25 during this past year. We have received over £800 in the last year through this scheme and they pay monthly which means there is a steady stream of income. There is an option to buy occasionally or have a monthly direct debit set up to buy a weekly ticket(s).
