



Christmas Diary Dates



- **Friday 22 November** - **Make Christmas decorations** at home for the school tree, to be returned by Thursday 28 November. These can be collected from school on the last day of term if you would like to take them home
- **Monday 25 November** - Parents are invited to school from 1.15 pm onwards to make decorations for the Christmas fayre. This will be organised by the FSA and decorations can be bought at the fayre. No upfront payment is needed. Please complete the parentmail form so that we can organise numbers.
- **Tuesday 26 November** - **Non uniform day in exchange for fayre donations.** Items could include: Sweets/chocolates, items for the tombola, books, old Christmas jumpers, toiletries, wine.
- **Friday 29 November** - **Christmas fayre - 3.30 - 5pm** - school hall and classrooms
- **Wednesday 4 December** – **Christmas Panto** in school – all year groups - £4 to pay on parentmail

PERFORMANCES
